NOTES

1. Discuss the 3 aspects of *agape* love: freedom, equal access, and impartiality. See p. 1.
2. God's *agape* love does not force, punish or control. In fact, it gives freedom of choice. Discuss ways that God deals with rebellion and at the same time maintains His standard of pure *agape* love.
3. Discuss how love without freedom is not love! Give examples, and also explain whether, if you disobey God, do you still have freedom? See p. 121.
4. Read 1 John 4:18. Discuss how you see evidence of this in your life.
5. Read Romans 12:21. This is a picture of fallen mankind, not God, yet many see God this way. Discuss how forceful or underhanded methods that people use to represent God are not in harmony with His principles that are represented by the Tree of Life.

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6. What does “just reward” mean? See p. 125.

7. Discuss why you think God allows “truth and falsehood to grow side by side” as illustrated in the parable of the tares and the wheat, p. 127. Discuss how this gives greater spiritual meaning to the end time harvest. See p. 127-129.

8. After reading pp. 130-131, discuss the meaning of “letting go means God respects our freedom of choice.”

9. Discuss how *agape* love’s freedom, equal access, and impartiality offers hope to every person on this earth.
